



**BY PARTICIPATING IN THE 2022 BOURBON AT BLACKACRE FUNDRAISING EVENT'S BUFFALO TRACE BOURBON RAFFLES, YOU AGREE TO THESE OFFICIAL RULES, WHICH ARE A CONTRACT.**

**1. Sponsor.** Blackacre Conservancy ("Blackacre Conservancy") is the sponsor of the 2022 Bourbon at Blackacre Fundraising event (the "Raffles"). Blackacre Conservancy is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. The purpose of the Raffles is to raise funds for the operation of Blackacre Conservancy in Louisville, KY and for the related activities of Blackacre Conservancy.

**2. Raffle Overview.** The Raffles begin on September 12, 2022 and end on October 13th, 2022, or when tickets are sold out, whichever occurs first.

**3. Eligibility.** Any person 21 years of age or older, residing in the United States where the Raffles are not prohibited, may purchase one or more tickets ("Ticket") to be entered in the Raffles (such person shall be herein known as the "Ticket Holder"). An affidavit of eligibility may be required from Ticket Holders who win a prize. Staff members of Blackacre Conservancy and their immediate family members (in this instance known as spouses and children), are prohibited from purchasing Tickets.

**4. Rules.** By purchasing a Ticket, each Ticket Holder accepts and agrees to be bound by all the rules, limitations, conditions, and restrictions set forth herein (the "Rules"), as well as all applicable local, state, and federal laws and regulations. Blackacre Conservancy's decisions in all matters concerning the Raffles and its interpretation and application of the Rules shall be final. Please contact Blackacre Conservancy if you have questions regarding the Rules or the Raffles. The Raffles are void where prohibited by law.

**5. Releases.** By purchasing a Ticket, each Ticket Holder releases Blackacre Conservancy, its directors, officers, employees, and agents, from any and all liability with respect to the Raffles, including, but not limited to, the selection process and the interpretation and application of the Rules, and from any and all liability for injuries, losses, or damages of any kind caused by any prize or resulting from acceptance, possession, use, or misuse of any prize, and each Ticket Holder agrees to indemnify and hold Blackacre Conservancy harmless from any and all losses, damages, rights, claims, and actions of any kind arising in connection with or as a result of the winner's acceptance or use of any prize. Each Ticket Holder agrees that their name, likeness, and any statements made by them regarding the prize may be disclosed to, and used by, the news media and may otherwise be used by Blackacre Conservancy for advertising or publicity purposes without compensation, and in any lists of prize winners to be published.

**6. Tickets.** The cost to purchase a Ticket for Three Bottles of Buffalo Trace Single Oak Project Bourbon is \$30.00 (U.S. Funds only). A maximum of 400 Three Bottles of Buffalo Trace Single Oak Project Bourbon Raffle Tickets will be sold.

The cost to purchase a Ticket for a Single Bottle of Buffalo Trace Single Oak Project Bourbon is \$20.00 (U.S. Funds only). A maximum of 200 Single Bottle of Buffalo Trace Single Oak Project Bourbon Raffle Tickets will be sold.

Each Ticket has one number. Each ticket qualifies as a raffle entry for one prize only. To be eligible to win both prizes, an entrant must purchase two separate tickets, one for each Raffle. Any eligible person may purchase more than one Ticket. Odds of winning depend on the number of valid Tickets sold. Tickets will not be sold after 8:30pm EDT, Thursday October 13, 2022. Any unsold tickets become the property of Blackacre Conservancy and will not be included in the drawings. Ticket Holders will receive an email confirmation of their payment that includes a payment confirmation ID. The payment confirmation ID should not be confused with Raffle Ticket numbers. Raffle Ticket numbers will be assigned to each Ticket Holder and posted online at [Visitblackacre.org/raffle](http://Visitblackacre.org/raffle). The IRS has taken the position that amounts paid for chances in raffles, lotteries, or similar drawings for valuable prizes are not gifts, and consequently do not qualify as deductible charitable contributions. A Ticket is not valid and shall not be entered in the Raffles until full and satisfactory payment for such Ticket is received by Blackacre Conservancy. Tickets are not transferable once purchased.

**7. Failure of Payment.** If a Ticket Holder's payment by credit card is declined or check is dishonored by the bank for any reason, such Ticket Holder's Ticket shall be invalid and will not be entered in the drawing, unless full and satisfactory payment is made by 8:30pm EDT, Saturday October 13, 2022. Blackacre Conservancy will endeavor to notify the invalidated Ticket Holder by phone at the number provided on the ticket purchasing website; however, any failure to do so shall not cause the Ticket to become valid, cause the Ticket to be entered in the Raffles, or give rise to any claim or cause of action on behalf of the invalidated Ticket Holder.

**8. Multiple-Party Tickets.** In the event that more than one name is listed on a Ticket, the first name listed shall be deemed to be the Ticket Holder. Delivery or payment of the prize shall be made to the Ticket Holder. It is the responsibility of the Ticket Holder to allocate any such prize among the participants in a multiple-party Ticket and Blackacre Conservancy, its directors, officers, employees, and agents, shall have no liability for any failure to do so.

**9. Raffle Drawings.** The Raffle Drawings shall take place on Thursday, October 13<sup>th</sup> 2022 at 8:30 pm EDT at 3200 Tucker Station Road, Louisville, KY 40299. Attendees of the Bourbon at Blackacre event must purchase an event ticket (limited in number) to view the raffle drawings. Anyone can view the raffle drawings live online at [www.facebook.com/BourbonMixer](http://www.facebook.com/BourbonMixer). In order to be eligible for the Raffle Drawings, a Ticket Holder must have purchased their Ticket online before 8:30pm EDT, Saturday August 20, 2022. The winning Ticket for each Raffle will be randomly chosen, and the winners of the prizes will be the Ticket Holders who have purchased a valid Ticket whose Ticket number matches the number chosen. If the Raffles are held, all prizes will be given away. If the Raffles are not held, all money will be returned to the Ticket Holders. There is no substitution of prizes. TICKET HOLDERS NEED NOT BE PRESENT TO WIN.

**10. Claiming a Prize.** Winning Ticket Holders will be notified by phone and/or email at the number or email address provided via website when purchasing the Ticket. Blackacre Conservancy shall notify the winners within three days of the drawing. The winners shall claim the prizes within thirty days of the drawing or will forfeit all rights to claim the prizes. The names of the winners will be available online at [www.bourbonmixer.com/raffle](http://www.bourbonmixer.com/raffle).

**11. Obligations of Winning Ticket Holders.** Except as otherwise provided herein, the Ticket Holders who win the prizes are responsible for all costs associated with that prize, including, but not limited to, any

local, state, and federal taxes that may be applicable. Ticket Holders are advised to consult with a tax advisor to determine any tax liabilities. The prize will be made available for in-person pick-up in Louisville, KY. Signature will be required upon delivery.

12. Raffle Prizes. There is one winner and one prize for the Three Bottles of Buffalo Trace Single Oak Project Bourbon, Rabbit Hole Kentucky Straight Rye Whiskey, Sazerac Rye Straight Rye Whiskey, Wilderness Trail Single Barrel KY Straight- Settlers Select Rye Whiskey, Wilderness Trail Single Barrel KY Straight- Bourbon Whiskey, Bradshaw KY Straight Bourbon Whiskey, Jim Beam Limited Release Distillers Cut, Cleveland The Eighty-Seven Bourbon Whiskey, New Riff KY Straight Rye Whiskey, New Riff KY Straight Bourbon Whiskey, and Daviess County KY Straight Bourbon Whiskey/ French Oak Casks.
